In compliance with the legal obligations regarding Article 33 of the European REACH Regulation N°1907/2006 on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals which entered into force on 1st of June 2007.

REACH/SVHC DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY

Dear Customers,

The EU's REACH Directive came into force on 1st of June 2007. It represents new European chemical legislation that has replaced some sections of the previous guidelines and directives.

REACH requires among others the registration of all chemical substances used or imported in the EU and all substances in preparations and products. The new directive applies to all chemical substances, regardless of whether or not they have any hazardous properties. They must be registered by manufactures and importers with the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) in Helsinki.

Due to our current knowledge the products of Varsi, d.o.o. do not contain any of substances published on the recent Candidate list <http://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table> (last updated: June 20th 2016) according to Article 59 (1, 10) of the REACH Directive and have been identified as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC). These substances may have very serious and often irreversible effects on humans and the environment.

Be assured that Varsi, d.o.o. will continue to monitor the REACH regulations for any new Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) that may be included in subsequent ECHA candidate lists.
